## 2020 PARNDANA SHOW PRESS RELEASE

The Parndana Show Society would like to welcome the community to attend the 61st annual Parndana Show to be held on Saturday November 14th. The society has been working hard behind the scenes to bring you this year's event in a Covid safe way so that everybody can have an enjoyable day out with friends and family.

However, the Society would like to ask the community to please follow are simple but important instructions and do the right thing so that we can achieve our goal of holding a community show in 2020.

### Travel:

When traveling to the event we urge families to travel together where possible to limit the amount of traffic on show day.

Where possible limit carpooling or mixing of people from other households while traveling to the event.

When parking please leave ample space between vehicles and allow others to move away from your vehicle before exiting.

### At the gate - Contact tracing:

Gate times - for show staff and exhibitors gates will open from 7:30am, for general public gates will open from 9:00am, gates will close for entry for general public from 5:00pm, gates will close for to all patrons, staff and exhibitors from 7:00pm the venue must be cleared after this time.

To help with traffic flow at the gate we ask that if you are not involved in any set up then it is best to plan to arrive after 9:00am, we can insure that you will not miss out on anything as all planned activities will start after this time.

When you arrive at the gate you will be asked to provide you contact tracing detail, those who refuse to do so will not be permitted to enter the venue. pre-fill forms will be made available to save time on queuing.

### Exhibitors:

All exhibitors are asked to stage their exhibits in a timely manner and once staged to leave the pavilion and do not hang around.

Limits have been set for indoor areas for capacity safety, please note that a short wait time may be needed before you can enter to stage your exhibits,

Exhibits must be staged before 10:00am

Use hand sanitiser where provided upon entry and exit, do not touch other exhibits.

### Capacity limits:

Please take note of capacity limits, Covid marshals will monitor throughout the day and you may be asked to wait before been able to entre indoor areas.

Maintain social distancing at all times 1.5m, limit large gatherings

### Hygiene:

Hand sanitiser will be provided throughout the event area, please use when entering indoor areas, after eating or drinking and using the toilet.

Masks are recommended when moving about with large crowds

Do not touch exhibits and limit touching of items at trade sites

If you feel unwell or have any symptoms, **PLEASE STAY AT HOME.**

### Eating & drinking:

When eating or drinking please do so in marked areas, signage will indicate where to sit or stand so that social distancing can be maintained.

After eating or drinking please dispose of rubbish in bins provided and wash or sanitise hand.

### Follow directions:

Please follow all directions by show staff and signage on show day.

Those who refuse to or continue not to follow staff directions will be asked to leave the event.

If we can all follow these simple instructions, we can all have a enjoyable day out together.
